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Hunterdon County Tricentennial Announces Photography Contest

Flemington, December 17, 2013 -- The Hunterdon County Tricentennial Committee is sponsoring a photography contest, in celebration of the Hunterdon County's 300th Anniversary in 2014. The theme, "*Celebrating 300 Years of Hunterdon County*" capturing unique images of Hunterdon County in two categories, Historical buildings in Hunterdon County and Events of the Tricentennial. Entries will be displayed in Assembly Space at the Hunterdon County complex at 314 State Route 12 bldg #1 in Flemington NJ from Friday November 7th, 2014 through Friday November 21st, 2014. Deadline for entries will be Monday October 6, 2014. Cash Prizes will be awarded!

Photographs must be taken within Hunterdon County between Midnight January 1st, 2014 and October 6th, 2014. Both residents and non-residents are welcome to submit photographs, but the contest is open to amateur photographers only. Age group categories include: adults (18 and up) and two categories for students, 17 years of age to 12 years of age and students 11 years of age and under. The submitted photographs, which must be 8"x10" size must be foam core board mounted, to 11"x14". Judging will take place in October 2014.

An opening reception of all the entries will take place on Friday November 7th, 2014 from 6:00pm to 8:00 pm. The winners of the contest will be announced that evening. The show will be on display from Friday November 7th, 2014 through Friday November 21st, 2014. The display will be closed on Tuesday November 11th in observance of Veterans Day. The hours to view the photographs on exhibit will be 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday thru Friday with hours on Saturday November 8th and the 15th from 10:00am to 4:00pm.

~BE A PART OF HUNTERDON'S HISTORY~

1. All photos entered must be taken in Hunterdon County between midnight January 1, 2014 and October 6, 2014.
2. This contest is open to amateur photographers only. Residents and Nonresidents are welcome to enter.
3. Each print must be accompanied by a separate entry form.
LIMIT of 2 prints per person.
4. All entries will be on exhibit at the, Hunterdon County Complex Building #1 at 314 State Route 12 , Flemington NJ 08822 from November 7th, 2014 through November 21st, 2014. Viewing hours for all the entries in the contest, will be from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. No exhibit hours will be held on Tuesday, November 11 in observation of Veteran's Day. Saturday hours will be on November 8th, 2014 and November 15th, 2014 from 10:00am to 4:00pm. There will be an opening reception on

Friday November 7th, 2014 from 6:00pm to 8:00 pm. Juried winners will be announced at the opening reception on Friday November 7th, 2014. The People's Choice award will be announced on November 21st, 2014. All children's entries will receive a prize of recognition.

5. There are TWO categories: Historic buildings in Hunterdon County and Events of the Hunterdon County Tricentennial, see the web site www.hunterdon300th.org for upcoming events.
6. Contestants can enter in either of the following age group categories:
Adults 18 and above, students ages 17 to 12 years old, and students ages 11 and under.
7. Entries must be prints, 8" x 10" in size ONLY mounted on foam core board 11"x14" in size; either color or black-and-white is accepted. Protection wrapping is recommended but not required. No framed photos!
8. No photo shopping or digital manipulation. This does not apply to photographic techniques contained within a camera's abilities, nor does it apply to cropping an image.
9. By entering you agree to let the Hunterdon County Tricentennial committee use the photos entered for promotional purposes, advertising or on their web site and/or on social media. The Hunterdon County Tricentennial is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged photos.
10. Deliver entries to: the North Branch of the Hunterdon County Library 65 Halstead St Clinton NJ during normal library hours. ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 1ST, 2014 THROUGH MONDAY OCTOBER 6TH 2014 ONLY. A receipt will be given for photo entries. You may pick up your entry on Friday November 21st between 2:30 and 4:30 pm at the assembly space, building #1 at 314 State Route 12 Flemington NJ 08822. All photos not picked up on this date become the property of the Hunterdon County Tricentennial committee.
11. Cash prizes to be awarded in each age group. 1st prize is \$100.00, 2nd prize is \$50.00 and 3rd prize is \$25.00. Only 1 prize will be awarded per person with the exception of the People's Choice Award. There will also be ONE People's Choice Award of \$100.00 to be awarded at the end of the show on Friday November 21st, 2014. Anyone may vote for your favorite photo while the show is on display at the Assembly space

between November 7th, 2014 through November 20th, 2014. One vote ONLY per person for the People's Choice. The people choice award will be mailed to the winner.

12. If the people's choice and the first place winners would like, they may donate their photo to be included into the Hunterdon County's Tricentennial time capsule to be opened in 2114.

13. This will be a juried show. Judges to be Walter Chorowezski , Walter Chandoha and Peter Sandrian.
