

**TOUR TEWKSBURY TOWNSHIP BY AUTO**  
August Event Part of Hunterdon County's 300<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration

The Tewksbury Historical Society, on behalf of the Township of Tewksbury, is sponsoring a tour of Tewksbury's historic and scenic roads by automobile on Sunday, August 17<sup>th</sup> between 10 am and 4 pm. The self-guided auto tour will be held rain or shine. Come take a drive through some of the most scenic areas of the Township while viewing sites of historic interest including lime kilns, truss and stone arch bridges, family farms and the many villages with their historic buildings. Test your knowledge of Tewksbury's past. Do you know where Pig Turd Alley or Clucas Corner are located? Look for the former Tewksbury one room schools in Bissell, Farmersville, Oldwick and Mountainville. Find out these and other interesting facts as one travels Tewksbury's 31.8 square miles. Stop off at the Tewksbury Historical Society in Mountainville for a break and also see the display on the Rockaway Valley Railroad. The Society will have its local history books, cards, afghans and prints of Tewksbury on sale.

The Auto Tour is Tewksbury Township's official anniversary event as part of Hunterdon County's 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary as approved by the Tewksbury Township Committee. The cost of the tour is \$ 10 per car and includes a tour booklet describing the sites of interest including historic and new photos and a map of the Township's roadway system. Additional copies of the booklet are available for \$ 5 each. All proceeds benefit the Tewksbury Historical Society.
